

The LeVerne W. Garcia Award for Outstanding Achievement was instituted to recognize an East Bay Chapter member for his or her distinguished service to the profession of public accounting, to the community or both. The award can be granted annually.

The award is a memorial to the late LeVerne W. Garcia who contributed extensively to the profession and numerous civic and professional organizations. He served as president of the East Bay Chapter, and secretary of the State Board of Accountancy. He was the first recipient of the Society's Distinguished Service Award. In addition, he founded Garcia, Erwin, Nishi and Kawasaki, CPAs, now known as Timpson Garcia, LLP.

Nominees should have demonstrated some or all of the following:

- **Leadership within the profession**
- **Fostering high professional standards within the profession**
- **Providing information and services beneficial to members**
- **Contributing as part of other professional activities**
- **Other actions promoting the vitality of the CPA profession**
- **Participating in community, charitable or other civic activities**
- **Having a significant positive impact on the community**
- **Serving in an outstanding manner as an appointed or elected official at the local, state or national level.**
